

DREDGING APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 1) Owner or Agent contacts Lake Inspector with verbal request of dredging.
- 2) Lake Inspector provides the Owner or Agent with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) contact information and AMWA dredging application procedures to the applicant.

- 3) Owner or Agent submits request to USACE.
- 4) USACE responds to request in writing by stating that 1) either an Individual Permit will be required or 2) they will state they believe the activity will fall under the Nationwide Permit for minor dredging.
- 5) A copy of the application submitted to USACE along with the USACE response letter is provided by applicant to the Lake Inspector for review.
- 6) If activity falls under the Nationwide Permit in the opinion of the USACE, the Lake Inspector will issue a permit.
- 7) If activity requires an individual permit from USACE, the applicant will be required to obtain that permit and then obtain approval by AMWA Board of Directors.
- 8) Lake Inspector will file all dredging permits, application and responses in that particular adjacent landowner's file and they shall be maintained indefinitely.
