1. Only Residents and Businesses in the following counties are eligible to compete: Smith, Cherokee, Anderson, Henderson and Rusk. The Bullard Area Chamber of Commerce has a non-discrimination policy that ensures it does not discriminate based on race, ethnicity, color, sex, religion, age, national origin, ancestry, citizenship, sexual orientation, gender identity and/or expression, or disability.
2. Entry fee is \$25.00 per entry. Only one entry per Team/Business.
3. Deadline for entry Oct 29th, 2018. All entries must be postmarked by Oct 29th, 2018 to compete.
4. Chili is to be served to the public between 12:00 PM – 2:00 PM. Contestants must have booth set up for duration of event, until 2PM. The Chamber will provide tasting cups, spoons and napkins to entrants for serving samples to public. Entrants please bring a serving utensil that serves 1oz portions.
5. Cook-Off winners will be announced from the main stage after 3 PM. The following awards will be presented:
 - First Prize - \$500 Cash Award plus Trophy
 - People's Choice Award - \$250 Cash Award plus Trophy
 - Showmanship Award - \$150 Cash Award plus Trophy
6. See Chili Rules and Regulations Form attached for rules in detail. The Rules and Regulation Form must be signed and returned with this application, along with entry fee of \$25.00 or entry will be invalid.
7. No vehicles, pets, campers, RV's or electric generators will be allowed in the cook-off area.

8. **NO BEER OR ALCOHOL** may be brought into the cook-off grounds or downtown venue. This is a **ZERO TOLERANCE** policy. Please make sure your entire team understands this policy. Be prepared to have your coolers and all containers inspected by Cook-Off Security. If you wish to use alcohol as an ingredient, The Chili Chairman must authorize the use and provide you with an approval document.
9. **PROPANE is REQUIRED**
10. Examples of approved devices include: yeti coolers, colored plastic cups, solo cups.
11. Sales of food, soda, water or any items are prohibited without prior written permission from the Chili Chairman. Commercial vendors will be contracted solely at the discretion of the Cook-Off Committee.
12. Any and all decisions made by the Chili Cook-Off Committee and Chili Chairman are final.

I have read and understand the cook-off rules. I agree that our team will be responsible for its set-up and clean-up of assigned booth area. I understand all funds are non-refundable. Funds will be considered a donation to The Bullard Chamber of Commerce for benefit of The Red, White and Blue Festival.
