Parade Rules and Regulations

- 1 No Semi Trucks, Dump Trucks, or RV's will be allowed in the Parade.
- 2. Each parade entrant must submit their entry form and waiver by the registration deadline.
- 3. There is no entry fee for the parade.
- 4. Floats should be decorated using the holiday theme appropriate for the celebration.
- 5. The Christmas Parade is an evening parade and appropriate lighting is expected.
- 6. Attach in a visible manner a sign or banner with the name of your business or group represented.

7. Floats must be decorated and ready to roll by parade start time. ARRIVE 1 HOUR BEFORE PARADE START TIME. Order of the parade will be predetermined by the Parade Committee. Your assigned position will be communicated to you at check in. There will be individuals available on the date of the parade to assist with getting entrants in order.

8. Inappropriate conduct is basis for automatic removal from the parade. Parade Chairman or law enforcement officials will make determination. This will include, but is not limited to, endangering or the potential of endangering anyone along the parade route.

9. All vehicles towing a float must have the float properly secured to the vehicle. 10. All horse entries will ride at the rear of the parade.

11. All horse entries will need to present a Negative Coggins Test at check in.

12. Any horse riders under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Each rider must be able to control their own horse.

13. Only registered floats and vehicles will be allowed to enter the parade line up.14. Walking units must be able to keep up with the speed of the parade and provide a banner or sign with sponsor or group name.

15. Performing groups are encouraged to perform. Please make note on your entry form if your group would like to showcase their act.

16. Check in for the parade will be on Panther Drive. Parking is located at High School and side of

Elementary School.

17. Floats will be judged in the following manner:

A. Spirit of Christmas

B. Most Unique

C. Most Entertaining

D. Friendliest

18. Float riders shall not unload from the float until it stops at the designated end point. If the float riders will be performing, riders may not unload until the float is stopped and the vehicle towing is in park. Only those groups who have coordinated with the Parade committee will be allowed to unload at City Hall and move to the performance area.
19. No candy or items can be thrown from entrants in the parade, for safety reasons.
