# HEAR PRESENTATION FROM JOHNNY MARTINEZ REGARDING FLY FISHING OPPORTUNITIES AND EVENTS IN ATHENS

Johnny Martinez made a presentation of the Fly Fishing Opportunity that he will be hosting on Lake Athens on April 9th. He is planning a two (2) day event that is free to the public, all they have to do is RSVP. He stated he is also a guide on Lake Athens for Fly Fishing.

### UPDATE FROM REPRESENTATIVES OF THE TEXAS ARTS FESTIVAL

Jed Turman introduced his assistant, Evan Manning, who is taking over the social media aspect of promoting the Texas Arts Festival. He stated the only obstacle he could foresee is with the artists paying for the booth space. He stated that the lowest price he could go was \$200 for a 10' x 10' booth space. He further stated that the host city artists will receive 30% off. Mr. Turman stated that there will be a kickoff party for all those involved with the Texas Arts Festival. He stated that his main concern would be filling up the fifty (50) booth spaces. He stated that he would like to see 2,500 people show up for the event.

#### COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT MANAGER'S UPDATE

Thanasis Kombos, Community Development Manager, stated that with some of the advertisements he questions the effectiveness of the ads. He stated that currently we have an ad space in the "D" Magazine and the cost is approximately \$2,500 for a 3" x 5" ad.

Member Priestley asked how many people this ad would reach.

Member Smiley asked what would be a better use of this money.

Mr. Kombos stated that this magazine would reach many people, but the bigger question is what the return on investment of this ad is. He stated strategic ad space to promote events works, but just a generic ad to vaguely describe Athens, he feels like that does not work.

Member Boswell stated that the board should look at where is the best place to promote certain events and focus on those ads.
