Notice of Public Hearing – Cain Center Agreement

Notice of Public Hearing - Business Assistance Grant Program

Executive Director Ahlers explained priority will be given to an area known as the downtown central business district. This area includes the square and two blocks off. The committee decided to include Hwy 175 east or west, Hwy 19, north or south, Hwy 31 east or west and Pinkerton Street.

There are four areas in which this grant can be approved. Façade improvement, sign improvement, property improvement and demolition. The ceiling amount is \$12,500 per grant and there is a mandatory matching funds for projects. The same committee will be reviewing these also.

The public hearing was opened.

Bill Burton spoke in reference to the North Athens area. This program would serve as a blessing.
