DISCUSS AND CONSIDER APPOINTMENT OF CIVIL SERVICE

EXAMINATION, QUESTION # 44) ADMINISTERED ON TUESDAY,
DECEMBER 10, 2013

Civil Service Commission Member Russell directed the Commission to refer to all exhibits that identified the test question referenced as number 44, the Police Officer's letter of appeal regarding question number 44 and a letter from IPMA, the Testing Facility showing an explanation of the correct test answer. Member Trent stated that he had reviewed all exhibits with information relating to the appealed test question. Member Trent also explained that after much review and consideration he had to agree with the IPMA Test Writer's opinion that Answer B was the correct answer. Member Russell explained that she also agreed with the IPMA Test Writer. A motion was made by Member Russell, seconded by Member Trent to sustain the answer key (test scores shall remain as reported). The motion carried unanimously.
