## ORDINANCE NO. O-131-19

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE O-102-19, THE TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020; PROVIDING A REPEAL AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** on September 9th, 2019, the Athens City Council approved its Budget Ordinance for the 2020 Fiscal Year; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City Charter, the City Council has the power to amend any unencumbered funds or appropriations by fund; and

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, additional budget appropriations are necessary to complete Fiscal Year 2019 ongoing projects; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council finds it in the public interest to amend the total Fiscal Year 2020 Budget by adding an additional \$204,553 to the General Fund; an additional \$5,000 to the Hotel Occupancy Tax Fund.

**WHEREAS**, the first reading of said Ordinance was conducted at a regular meeting of City Council on November 25, 2019 per the City's Charter Article III, Section 3.11.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATHENS, TEXAS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The findings and recitations set out in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct, and they are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purpose.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Council hereby authorizes an amendment in the amounts listed below to the total appropriations as outlined incorporated herein for all intents and purposes.

<u>Section 3.</u> Should any clause, phrase, sentence or section of this Ordinance be deemed invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said finding shall not affect the remaining clauses, phrases, sentences or sections of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 4.</u> Any ordinance, resolution or order previously passed and/or adopted by the City Council, or any part thereof, if found to be in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be resolved in favor of the terms and conditions of this Ordinance, and any prior conflicting ordinance, resolution or order or any part thereof, is hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

<u>Section 5.</u> This Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Athens, Texas.
