ORDINANCE NO. 2022-O-013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATHENS, TEXAS ORDERING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON MAY 7, 2022 FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTER CONSIDERATION FOR A REDUCTION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF ATHENS DEDICATED FOR THE BENEFIT OF A SECTION 4B ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FROM ONE-HALF (1/2) OF ONE PERCENT TO ONE-FOURTH (1/4) OF ONE PERCENT AND INCREASING THE SALES AND USE TAX DESIGNATED FOR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF FROM ONE-HALF (1/2) OF ONE PERCENT TO FIVE-EIGHTHS (5/8) OF ONE PERCENT AND INCREASING THE SALES AND USE TAX DESIGNATED FOR GENERAL REVENUE FROM ONE-PERCENT (1) TO ONE AND ONE-EIGHTHS (1-1/8) OF A PERCENT AND DESIGNATING THE PLACE OF HOLDING SUCH ELECTION; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Athens is a Home Rule Municipality located in Henderson County, created in accordance with statutes of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2005, a Special Election was held for the purpose of voter consideration of dissolution of A.E.D.C. and adopting of Section 4B Sales and use Tax; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 321 of the Texas Tax Code, the combined rate of all sales and use taxes imposed by the municipality and other political subdivisions of this state having territory in the municipality will not exceed two (2) percent; and

WHEREAS, Section 41.001(a), Election Code, provides that except as otherwise provided for, each general or special election in this state shall be held on the first Saturday in May or the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November; and

WHEREAS, all constitutional, statutory, and legal prerequisites for the passage of this Ordinance have been met, including but not limited to the Open Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, the Council hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Athens to hold this election on May 7, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATHENS, TEXAS, THAT:

INCORPORATION OF PREMISES

The above and foregoing premises are true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION II ELECTION ORDERED

The City of Athens hereby orders that a Special Election be held on May 7, 2022, being the first Saturday in May, for the purposes of reducing the local sales and use tax dedicated for the benefit of a Section 4B Economic Development Corporation from one-half (1/2) of one percent to one-fourth (1/4) of one percent and increasing the sales and use tax designated for property tax relief from one-half (1/2) of one percent to five-eighths (5/8) of one percent and increasing the sales and use tax designated for general revenue from one-percent (1) to one and one-eighths (1-1/8) of a percent.

SECTION III BALLOT LANGUAGE

The ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code so that voters may cast their ballots either "FOR" or "AGAINST" the following proposition which shall appear on the ballot in substantially the following form:

"THE REDUCTION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF ATHENS DEDICATED FOR THE BENEFIT OF A SECTION 4B ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FROM ONE-HALF (1/2) OF ONE PERCENT TO ONE-FOURTH (1/4) OF ONE PERCENT AND INCREASING THE SALES AND USE TAX DESIGNATED FOR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF FROM ONE-HALF (1/2) OF ONE PERCENT TO FIVE-EIGHTHS (5/8) OF ONE PERCENT AND INCREASING THE SALES AND USE TAX DESIGNATED FOR GENERAL REVENUE FROM ONE-PERCENT (1) TO ONE AND ONE-EIGHTHS (1-1/8) OF A PERCENT

SECTION IV PRECINCTS

The election precinct for said election shall be the regular precinct of Henderson County to the extent that they are within the corporate limits of the City of Athens.

SECTION V ADMINISTRATION OF ELECTION

The Special Election shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute such election agreement for the election for and on behalf of the City, with all expenses of the joint election borne as outlined in the election agreement. The City of Athens will contract with Henderson County for a joint election.

SECTION VI EARLY VOTING CLERKS

(a) In accordance with Sections 31.097 and 271.006 of the Texas Election Code, the following named person is hereby appointed as the Early Voting Clerk for the purposes of conducting said election:

- (b) Presiding Judge of the Early Voting Ballot Board: to be determined by Paula Ludtke Henderson County Election Center, 201 East Larkin Street, Athens Texas 75751
- (c) Any permanent county employee serving under the Elections Administrator shall serve as deputy early voting clerks.

SECTION VII NOTICE AND PUBLICATION

Notice of the Election shall be given by posting a notice of election in both English and Spanish at City Hall located at 508 E. Tyler St. Athens, Texas on the bulletin board not later than twenty-one (21) days prior to the date upon which the Election is to be held, and by publication of said notice at least once in the official newspaper of the City of Athens being a newspaper of general circulation within the City the date of said publication to be not less than ten (10) days nor more than thirty (30) days prior to the date set for the Election. Upon publication of the election notice, the City Secretary shall secure a publisher's affidavit.

In addition, thereto, a copy of the notice shall also be filed with the City Secretary at least twenty-one (21) days before the Election.
