

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-O-051

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ATHENS, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2020-O-073, TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2021; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 24th, 2020, the City Council approved its Budget Ordinance for the 2021 Fiscal Year;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter, the City Council has the power to amend any unencumbered funds or appropriations by fund;

WHEREAS, on April 26th, 2021, the Athens City Council approved Resolution 2021-R-040 for capital financing of 7 Public Safety Vehicles and directed staff to purchase equipment;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the public interest to amend the total Fiscal Year 2021 Budget by increasing budgeted expenditures an additional \$142,724;

WHEREAS, on May 10th, 2021, the City Council of the City of Athens, Texas, after due notice read aloud the Ordinance amendment for the first time as required by Article III, Section 3.11 of the City of Athens Charter.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATHENS, TEXAS:

Section 1. The findings and recitations set out in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes an amendment in the amounts listed below to the total appropriations as outlined incorporated herein for all intents and purposes.

General Fund:

10-546-6504	Equipment for Fire Services Vehicle	\$5,463
10-551-6504	Equipment for Police Admin Vehicle	\$17,337
10-552-6504	Equipment for Police CID Vehicles	\$30,039
10-553-6504	Equipment for Police Patrol Vehicles	\$89,885

Section 3. Any Ordinance, Resolution or Order previously passed and/or adopted by the City Council, or any part thereof, if found to be in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be resolved in favor of the terms and conditions of this Ordinance, and any prior conflicting

Ordinance, Resolution or Order or any part thereof, is hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section 4. Should any clause, phrase, sentence, or section of this Ordinance be deemed invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said finding shall not affect the remaining clauses, phrases, sentences, or sections of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be and become effective from and after its adoption and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Athens, Texas.
