First United Methodist Church of Orange Rules for Facility & Kitchen Use JULY, 2017

GENERAL RULES:

Children below the age of 18 must have adult supervision at all times while using the Church facilities

- A custodian, Church staff member of person designated by the Pastor/Staff must be on premises when the Church is in use.
- Alcoholic beverages or controlled substances are prohibited on Church property.
- Smoking is prohibited in the Church buildings.
- No fireworks, firearms or weapons are permitted on Church property.
- Alterations to thermostat settings must be made by the Church representative designated during Church use.
- Decorations to Church property should be undertaken only after presenting details and receiving permission from the Pastor/Staff. Confetti, bird seed, raw rice or other small items are strictly prohibited.
- No items shall be glued, taped, stapled, nailed, screwed or tacked to any furnishings, walls, doors or windows.
- Audio/visual equipment is available and may be checked out by contacting the Director of Music & Fine Arts. All buildings are to remain locked when not in use.
- Cleaning charges may be waived (with permission) but no harsh chemicals may be used on the floors or other areas.
 - A neutral cleaner must be used, along with mops and cleaning utensils available in the building.
 - Do not use a wet swifter or Fabuloso as it will cause damage to the floors.
- Food or beverages are prohibited in areas with carpet.
- Spills in any area of the facility must be called to the attention of the adult in charge and immediately cleaned.
- The adult in charge should double check that all lights, appliances, and thermostat settings are turned off or set properly.
- Thermostat settings should be left at temperatures per instructions (78 degrees for AC, 60 degrees for Heat).

KITCHEN RULES

Tables, countertops, stovetop and ovens must be wiped clean of all debris and spills.

- Return all items to their proper place.
- Put all trash in the dumpster (located in parking lot at corner of Sixth Street & Pine Avenue)
- Wash and store all dishes and utensils. This includes any appliances used, such as coffee pots & popcorn machine. Remove all left over food and supplies from the premises.
- Please bring your own paper goods and other supplies for non-church related activities.
- If necessary, sweep and mop the area using only neutral cleaners and supplies that will not damage the floors and appliances. Double check to ensure that all lights and appliances are turned off - - including stove, oven, coffee pots, etc.

NOTE: A CHECK LIST WILL BE PROVIDED FOR COMPLETION UPON LEAVING THE FACILITIES (REQUIRED FOR DEPOSIT REFUND) VIOLATIONS TO THE RULES ABOVE COULD RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF DAMAGE DEPOSIT
