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








Guiding Principles

- Developed by SPRC, Adopted by VCI Team and Charge Conference
- Covers the organization of the Church Council (Small Board Model)
 - 13 Roles Pastor, SPR, Finance, Trustees, Lay Ldr, Secretary, At Large
 - Council makes all major decisions...
 - Task Teams for Finance, Trustees and SPRC work within Council
- Sets the responsibilities/expectations of the Pastor, Chair, Financial standards
 - Missions and Task Teams work within Budget...expenditures> $$1000 \rightarrow Council$
- Interactions with Congregation
 - Council Meeting Agendas are set a week before meetings (currently 3rd Thurs)
 - Submit issues/requests to any Council member
 - Executive sessions will be held for Staff discussions...visitors excused





READ AND DISCUSS WORSHIP RESOURCES

- Redesigning Worship (Kim Miller)
 - Planning a worship service is far more than just choosing songs and seasonal images. Helping people to genuinely worship God requires creating an experience through which people can enter into the presence of the divine. This descriptive book offers practical direction for building and leading teams, empowering creative ideas, and guidance for handling conflict and overcoming serious obstacles.
- Taking Flight With Creativity (Len Wilson and Jason Moore)
 - Using the metaphor of early flight, this resource analyzes how to be a part of a worship design team that works.
