Blessing Box Sunday—June 25

Have <u>you</u> checked out our Blessing Box at the entrance of the Family Life Center? It's under the portico for ease of access and protection from the elements and will have a sign soon!

The <u>community</u> has found it and shops from it often! The items most in demand are toilet paper, cleaning supplies, and personal hygiene items. Food does not seem to move very quickly.



You can add items directly to the box at anytime, but we'll have a **special blessing day on Sunday, June 25.** Bring your Blessing Box items to the altar at any service. We'll cover each item in prayer during the service and ask God to continue to use our church as a vessel of generosity and love for our neighbors.

Back to School Orange—August 5

Back to School Orange is set for Saturday, August 5, and organizers hope to keep it on the first Saturday from now on. The goal is to distribute 1,100 school supply kits this year, including preK kits.

First UMC-Orange can contribute and support the event. In any of these four ways:

- 1) Encourage any Orange County child to preregister.

- Volunteer for line control during the event. Committed volunteers need to provide their shirt size (for Back-to-School t-shirt) to Angela Abshire and will need to attend the volunteer walk-through on Thursday afternoon, August 3.
- 4) Volunteer to work our First UMC Orange table. Wear your personal First UMC Orange shirt. We distribute personal hygiene kits with items such as deodorant, combs, or hairbrushes.
- 5) Donate items (see #4) to distribute at our table.
