#### **CHURCH LIFE 101: BACK TO THE BASICS**

September will always be Back to School time for me, whether school begins in August or not. We always started classes after Labor Day. In fact, Labor Day was always celebrated as a final celebration of summer. I'm sure you remember fond times of new school supplies, new school shoes, folding brown paper sacks carefully over your new textbooks to protect them from grimy kid prints, and lots more.

This month we will be exploring the basics of church life together with a sermon series that will highlight different aspects of our lives together as disciples of Jesus Christ here in Orange, Texas. One student came to me this past week and spoke about homework on the first night of school. "It was easy. A review. I got it finished really fast." I remember those early assignments when everything seemed like something you already knew from the previous year. Well, that's what we will be doing in September, reviewing what you probably know or learned along the way, but maybe something new will be discovered about our commitments to our Savior.

I have been delighted to discover so much talent here in Orange. I told someone after the Dinner Theater performances that I think I'd been dreaming of a place like this all my days! God used music to draw me into the life of the church, it all started with an invitation to sing in the choir at my neighborhood United Methodist Church. I began studying the Bible weekly and attending rehearsals and Sunday morning worship services. I learned a lot about God and Jesus and the church straight from the hymns we sang. And in those days, we had folks coming forward to join our church nearly every weekend. So we were addressed by the pastor, "Members of the household of God, I commend these persons to your love and care. Do all in your power to increase their faith, confirm their hope, and perfect them in love." Our response was, "We give thanks for all that God has already given you and we welcome you in Christian love. As members together with you in the body of Christ and in this congregation of the United Methodist Church, we renew our covenant faithfully to participate in the ministries of the church by our prayers, our presence, our gifts, and our service\*, that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ." (\*at General Conference in 2008, a fifth commitment was added to our vows—witness.)

Discipleship happens for the church all year long. We learn and grow together. I'm looking forward to Wednesday Night Live and other weekly happenings...I hope you are, too.



#### A NEW Ladies' Bible Study begins Sunday, September 8

The enemy wants us to feel rejected...left out, lonely, and less than. When we allow him to speak lies through our rejection, he pickpockets our purpose. Cripples our courage. Dismantles our dreams. And blinds us to the beauty of Christ's powerful love.

In Uninvited, Lysa shares her own deeply personal experiences with rejection—from the incredibly painful childhood abandonment by her father to the perceived judgment of the perfectly toned woman one elliptical over. She leans in to honestly examine the roots of rejection, as well as rejection's ability to poison relationships from the inside out, including our relationship with God.



With biblical depth, gut-honest vulnerability, and refreshing wit, Lysa will help you:

- Stop feeling left out by believing that even when you are overlooked by others you are handpicked by God.
- Change your tendency to either fall apart or control the actions of others by embracing God-honoring ways to process your hurt.
- Know exactly what to pray for the next ten days to steady your soul and restore your confidence in the midst of rejection.
- Overcome the two core fears that feed your insecurities by understanding the secret of belonging.

Uninvited reminds us we are destined for a love that can never be diminished, tarnished, shaken, or taken—a love that does not reject or uninvite. Please talk with Nicole Watzlavik if interested in taking the class.



September is Christian Education Month

#### THE PURPOSE OF CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Through Christian education we invite people and communities of faith to be transformed as they are inspired and challenged to:

- Know and experience God through Jesus Christ
- Claim and live God's promises
- Grow and serve as Christian disciples

Jesus said that God's kingdom is like fishermen who cast their net into the water. When the net was full, they pulled it in. The net caught all kinds of things, good and bad; fish that were edible and those that were not. So the fishermen separated out what was good and threw the rest back in the water. At the end of this age, God's angels will separate the evil from the righteous. Similarly, **a scribe or Bible teacher** who has been trained for God's kingdom is wise.
