Dear Pastor & Church,

Greetings in our Lord's all sufficient grace.

Jesus says: **"The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel."** Mark 1: 15

I believe that the most obstacle in any Christian Mission Field is almost the absence of **"repentance"**. It is not a surprise to find out, in a way or another, that millions multiplied by millions of US \$ were spent for missions all over the world to preach a Gospel which is deprived from the most important factor which our Lord had emphasized and mentioned the importance of **REPENTANCE**. It is very obvious and very clear understood what our Lord says in **Mark 1: 15 "repent ye, and believe the gospel."** A five years old boy can very well understand the meaning and importance of this verse: **"repent.. and believe .."** **I feel very sorry to say that the tragedy nowadays is that we, very rare, may hear these essentials requirements for salvation from the mouth of the modern preachers!!** It is not enough to bring people to our churches in large numbers and preach a gospel to them **deprived** from the most essential requirements for true salvation. Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."** And we read in Acts 8: 22 **"Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee."** And we read in Rev. 2: 5 **"Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent."** This is besides many other references concerning this vital subject.

Anyway my purpose of this letter is to share with you what is in my heart about the need for all our Independent Baptist Churches to cooperate in prayers to maintain our pure and true preaching of the word of God without any kind of compromise for the glory of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

ACTIVITES

Many of the refugees are still able to attend our evangelical ministries besides the nationals. We still have a great ministry among the kids in the South of Lebanon besides the ministry to the adults as well.

Our ministry in the **South of Syria**, where the majority are from a religion called "Drouz", is still going on. Many got saved over there where our Missionary resides for this purpose. He is doing a great job in preaching, teaching, evangelizing, and visiting a lot of families in that city...

Our new evangelical ministry in "Alnabaa", close to the capital of Lebanon is growing and people over there are receptive to the word of God. Our missionary in that area is doing a great job.
