We are no longer able to meet in the local community building because of covid, so we are meeting in their homes and I know how much extra stress that puts on the families, so pray for them too!

We, our mission, had the opportunity to go with our children to visit the local Police Station and later at another time the Fire Station. They were a little unsure about letting us come but they did finely allow us to come. The ladies made cookies and different other goodies. Of course we all had our masks on as the children handed them their bags of goodies. I could tell that this was the first time any such thing had happened on their watch! Praise the Lord for his

working in lives! We all had tracks, letters and pictures that the kids had written. The folks seemed to really appreciate it!

Our church also went caroling, there were 18 children and 12 adults that sang. They had a great time doing this and the people came out into the streets to hear in many places that they stopped at. We pray that it will bring eternal effects! I was not able to go, but they did come and caroled to me also! I think this must have been the first time something like this had happened for some that they caroled to!
