This past five months for my wife and I has not been any thing what we would have wanted or planned. Yet God has sustained us and Annette is still alive praise his name. We are so thankful for everyone that have been praying for us during this time and sent special love offerings to help with all the medical! WE never stop learning to have to trust the Lord as he directs our paths and even changing that path !

Back in September we planned on coming back to Alaska and spending time with our new home Church Badger Road Baptist and the family. I and Annette ended up with COVID a week after we arrived. My son Alex took care of us both for the next three weeks. I did ok with it just very tired. But it put Annette into a diabetic keto acidosis. So she spent the next 4 days in ICU very sick. Then for the next four months she has been in and out of the hospital at least eight times and one more time in ICU with heart failure. Her heart was only working at 10 percent and they had to bring her back. She got Belle palsy, the shingles, she had three UTI. Our daughter Crystal and her family have been helping with taking care of Annette which I am so thankful for.

Then I had an attack with my hernia operation that failed from Hawaii I had done last year, so I had to redo this surgery and I am healing up but it just seems very slow. We are staying with our son Clinton and family until after and I could fly back up to Fairbanks and be with Annette and my daughters home. We are so thankful for everyone that brought meals visited gave funds. The love that has been shown has so been appreciated and only our heavenly father could repay each of you and we pray he does bless all of you all in great ways!

We also were able to set a date to organize the church work in Hawaii. We are so excited to see how the Lord has been working there. It was the 13 of February and Travis Chace feels the call of taking over the work. So we will also be ordaining Travis Chace in this process. He has proven himself in the work there and has a love and pastors heart for the people. I praise the Lord for His working out all the details and for everyone that took part.

My plan Lord willing, is to stay on and help as much as we can, and see what God has in mind?!

I have made one trip so far with my brother Dan Chace who was able to go with me and we are holding Sunday afternoon service with a family that is apart of the work here but they drive 2 1/2 hours one way. So we are seeing what the Lord will open up!

At Christmas the group was able to do Christmas caroling around our community we got some very good feed back from different folks which is always a blessing that seeds can be planted.

The group has been studying Church covenant, by laws that will be adopted and the statement of faith. There are several bible studies that are going on with different folks that Travis is working with them that need to be saved !

Annette and I were able to celebrate our 44 years of marriage together this month and we once again can only praise the Lord for giving us such years and time together !
