The Dr. had Joe to make his decision. On Friday November 6th, Joe will have surgery to remove the eye and prepare for a prosthetic eye. It will be fitted and placed after he heals from the surgery.

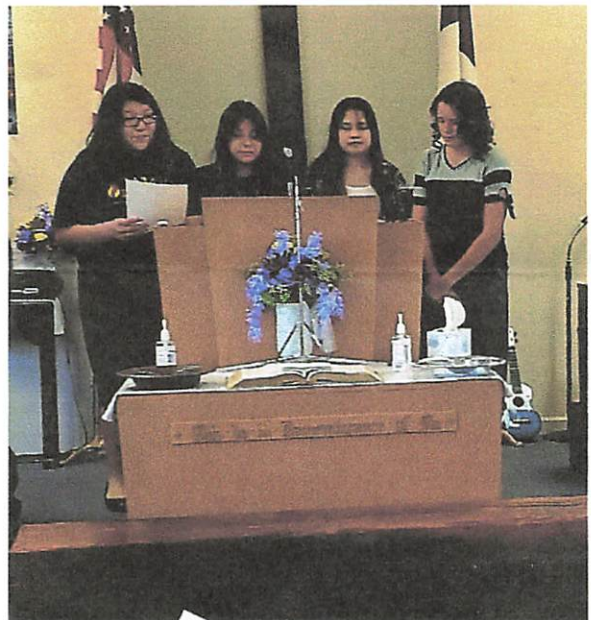
