The battles have been startling. We've had 1 funeral. The ones who seem to work hard in the church are experiencing struggles. One home has an older child dyeing of cirrhosis. One has wayward children which is causing many problems, child custody battles. Two homes have children incarcerated.

Sin plays hard on families. Yet many are faithful to attend and serve.

The people are bringing in visitors. One 16-year-old came and got saved on a Sunday night. She brought her 17-year-old sister and she got saved on Wednesday night. When I stopped to pick them up on the bus on the following Sunday morning, they told me "Mom is coming to church to get saved," And she did. Sunday night they were back and I asked them how their day went. The Mom said, "Best day ever." Two women got saved that Sunday morning. It was an amazing service.

When we tire physically and seem to be so far behind with obligations, God swoops down and lifts us to Spiritual Heights, that only HE can help us reach. We feel honored in our senior years to be so engaged in HIS work.

Thanks to many who make this possible. One of these is Mya. She is 16 now and will do anything she can to help us. Her health is weak from years of stress, but her sweet spirit and discernment are ready and available to jump in with a helping hand. We have several other teens in the church that are of the same nature. We have truly been blessed.
