It is interesting how the Lord supplies our needs by means of the churches, so that we are enabled to carry out the Great Commission.

On February 26th we will joyfully begin this year's distribution of the "Learn with Jesus" books. In this first stage, we will be donating 14,000 books in different regions of the country. The doors remain open and it is a joy to see the public schools using these truly biblical materials to teach the children about what the Bible says.

Each month that the Lord allows us, we intend to go to a new region with the textbooks, Bibles for the teachers, and evangelistic material for the parents throughout the country. My vision is to keep filling the country with the message of Christ. That is what produces a real transformation in each person who receives Him.

Beloved, during the next two months, with the Lord's help and the participation of the brethren from the local churches, we hope to have tract distribution campaigns in Santiago, Penonomé, and San Francisco. We intend to pass out 10,000 tracts in each place. We are having them printed now at a cost of three cents each.

So far this year we have helped with four conferences in different places. The first was January 14 in Palma Real in Colón province, where the theme was "Repentance". Then a one day seminar in Penonomé, January 27, theme, "Security of the Believer", next was a four day family camp near Cañazas, which was attended by several churches. The theme was "Raising a godly seed, Malachi 2:15". February 24 the event was the 11th anniversary of the church in Cañazas, which now has four missions and two fulltime missionaries, along with other men who are active in the ministry. In the midst of these events we saw several professions of faith, others who rededicated their lives to the Lord, and many who were blessed by the preaching of the Word.
