

We are focusing now on training and renewing our efforts in personal and organized evangelism. I am grateful to Beacon of Truth Ministries for freely providing us with several thousand Gospel tracts. The believers here are actively distributing them throughout the town area and to their family members. This month we are planning to start organized visitation once again. Please pray with us that we will find hearts that are receptive to the true Gospel message.



I am pleased to report that a couple of people who were saved in the church almost two years ago have finally been able to be baptized and added to the church! Sione and Eni started coming to church through the personal witness of Laau and Taea. They both made professions of faith, but it is only in the past several months that we have seen some real conviction to make things right in their home and family. The last weekend of September, I was honored to be able to officiate their wedding. They were baptized the very next day! We pray that the Lord will bless their marriage and will continue to help them grow in their faith and walk with Him.

Another young couple recently started attending church and also made professions of faith a few weeks ago. They are expecting their first child, but are not married. Please pray with us that they will grow in the Lord and make things right before the Lord concerning their relationship.

Finally, Bro. Ben, who moved with his family to New Zealand last year, is still an active part of our ministry as he helps us by developing a new website for the church. He is going to set it up so that we will be able to use our radio studio to do some online broadcasting of sermons and podcasts. I am excited about this as it will be a great way to reach out to Samoan speaking people even beyond the borders of our little island group.
