Dear Pastor & Church,

Greetings in our Lord's all sufficient grace.

"The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: He turneth it whithersoever he will." Proverb 21: 1

As we mentioned in our previous letter that a very large explosion took place at the port of Beirut, the capital of Lebanon. As a result, up to my knowledge, 300,000 displaced from homes, 135 persons died, 5000 injured in the explosion in Beirut on Aug. 04,2020 the blast was linked to chemicals stored in port warehouse. Hundreds of thousands of people got hurt. Over 10,000 homes were affected by the massive explosive. According to a certain Lebanese News paper: half of the population became poor, and 1,000,000 persons without work or job. So then, it is very clear that our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ Whose heart is still upon the lost souls as we read in 1 Timothy 2: 4 **"Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth."** Consequently the door were widely opened for many organizations of several backgrounds to come and do something to help in different fields, as the need of the people were tremendous that is: hospitalization, medicine, fixing homes, etc.. etc... During this conflict our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ opened the door in a miraculous way to preach the Gospel of salvation through personal contact and visitation to many homes. To our surprise we found many of those broken hearts were widely opened with a listening ear to the message of salvation. **What is remarkable in this case that when Lebanon was peaceful and prosperous it was very difficult to visit any home for preaching the Gospel to them... But now, praise and glory to the Lord our God, many doors are widely open for the Gospel.** This does not mean the everything was going easily and smoothly, there were some opponents to the Gospel specially from Moslem people (*who are related to Mohammad...*) But, as we can see it, this is a good sign that our Lord is working tremendously in several hearts of the lost.

During many years of our experience in the ministry in Lebanon, we never saw an opened field for preaching the gospel of salvation as we can see now during this conflict. **So then, we can see that our mighty God can changes the tribulation to a good field for His missionaries to spread the word of God to a blind world who got involved in heresies and false doctrines...**

What is also remarkable during this tribulation that our Lord **"hath set apart him that is godly for himself: the Lord will hear when I call unto him."** Psalm 4: 3 we, also, are experiencing what we read in Psalm 34: 10 **"The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing."** **We are truly overwhelmed in His mercies.**

Our remarkable activity is in the area of the massive explosion where we could hire a place as a center for our new evangelical activities where we could reach many individuals and families for preaching the Gospel of Salvation to the lost. What a blessing!
