Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ and friends around the world. Greetings in the name of our wonderful Savior and Lord Jesus Christ.

In my last letter I asked you all to pray especially for us as we had many decisions to make. I would like to thank all of you who have been praying for us. The Lord has blessed us in our walk by faith. After many prayers, I had peace in my heart to try and sell our home. Not knowing where we would go yet, but trusting in the Lord, that He would provide according to His will. Many people came to see our home but they all thought we were asking too much for it. One interesting thing was, people always asked us where we were going to move to and I would answer, "we don't know". They would then ask me how I could sell not knowing where we would go. It gave me an opportunity to talk about my Lord and His promises in the Bible. It was in April that we put the for sale sign on it and in the last week of May, the Lord blessed and an elderly couple from Stockholm was willing to pay the price we were asking. They had not seen the house in person, but had only seen pictures of it. The contract was written and sent by mail. In the contract we wrote that the new owners could move in on September 7th, still not knowing where we would go. The Lord blessed our walk by faith and answered our prayers. On July 13<sup>th</sup> we found out that in Spjutstorp, 4 miles from our house, a man is fixing up an old school house, to rent out to people visiting in the summer. It is still not finished, but we were promised that we could move in on September 1<sup>st</sup> and stay until the first week of November. The place will be furnished with everything and the rent will only be \$600 a month including electric and water. I have already been able to move some of our things to Klippan because one of my mother's neighbors is letting us use his storage place. The main reason we made the decision to move is that we really feel the Lord is closing the doors here in Tomelilla. As I take care of my mother in Klippan, it seems more people

up there are interested in the Word of God. One of the nurses, who help my mother, asked me if I had some more of tracts that I had been giving out because she has some friends who are interested in learning more from the Word of God. The second reason for wanting to move is that my mother is getting worse and if Lord would let me, I would like to be able to move closer to her so that I can help her more. Please pray with us as we take this step by faith, not knowing where to go, but trusting that the Lord will open up a place for us to be able to live closer to my mother and reach out from there with the Gospel of Christ. Last year I had the opportunity to work in an agriculture place during the harvest time. They called me and asked if I could help them again this year. I told them yes. July 20<sup>th</sup> is the starting day and it usually lasts a little more than a month. The reason I told them yes is that last year I worked with one man named Patrick. He was very open to the Word of God and it was him that told his boss to call me. This time Patrick and I will work the same shift. Please pray for him especially and also for me that I will be able to share the Word of God not only with Patrick, but also with the farmers and truckers who are bringing in the crops.

So I finish this letter asking you all to please pray for me and Masayo as we try to reach out with the Gospel of Christ to all the people that come in our way and that we live our life by faith in His Word so God will be glorified and honored.
