Hello from the mountains of Ecuador! I hope this prayer letter finds you well and blessed in our Lord Jesus Christ and that your work for Him is blessed. It is tremendous to know that God came in the person of Jesus Christ to pay for our sins and justify us so that we can have a home in heaven. All that is required to receive this gift is repentance and belief.

The work here in El Quinche, Ecuador, continues at a slow pace. We currently have six members of the mission and approximately ten faithful visitors to our services and Bible studies. I am currently working with them on sharing their faith and helping others to grow which is brought about by a love for God which allows us to love our neighbor. I am still looking for a man to train for this work in El Quinche, and I ask you to pray for this.

The print shop is about to be put to good use. I wrote a new tract based on the 5 A's of Evangelism, which is a Gospel presentation that I teach to all our disciples in Christ. We have just finished editing it, and I am about to start printing. I am excited to see what the reaction will be to it. Hopefully it will have more of a response than the tracts that we have passed out previously which have produced little response. Please pray for this new evangelistic push that I have planned for the next several months.

The work in the high mountains of Ecuador, specifically in the village of Compañia, is back on track after a period of uncertainty due to sickness and the village holding work days on the key day of Bible study. Bother Segundo, the leader of the group, came to visit with me, and he expressed his desire to continue to be trained in the ministry and asked for help for the Sunday morning services until he feels he can preach effectively. This was an answer from the Lord and confirmation that they want to continue and have a definite desire to do something for the Lord. Please pray for this indigenous work.

I want to thank you for your prayers for us and the work! This Friday we have our appointment to obtain residency here. We appreciate your prayers and the financial help as well which allows us to minister in this needy country of Ecuador. May God bless you richly!
