Greetings to you from our current furlough stop in southeastern Arizona. The Lord has tremendously blessed us these past few months with safety as we traveled, provision for our needs, and refreshing fellowship with the believers in the churches we have visited. Beyond that, we have been nourished from God's Word and feel revitalized for this next term in Samoa. We are looking forward to this final stretch of furlough before we depart for Samoa on June 12.

These past three months have been spent reporting to churches in Texas, Georgia, Indiana, New Mexico and Arizona. Whether we have had meetings scheduled or just stopped in for a visit, we have been welcomed and gathered in like family. Through the generosity of God's people, all of our traveling expenses have been more than covered. Anything beyond that is going toward our expenses for getting back to the field or put toward needs for the radio ministry.

It is a blessing to be used wherever we travel, but we have been thrilled to be a part of various ministries while in Safford, Arizona, as we have stayed here for an extended visit. Robyn was able to sing in an Easter cantata as well as play the piano for a nursing home ministry. Pene was blessed to be invited to preach twice on the Apache Reservation in Bylas, Arizona. In the midst of packing and shipping our belongings, we will continue reporting to churches and finishing up with our Spring Semester of Bible Institute.
