We have been approved to continue the program again this August through August of 2027. Please pray with us that God supplies the needs for this wonderful program. We



will have to cover the teachers' payments since they will be coming to the home to teach classes in addition to covering the support materials they need. We will find out what the actual cost will be later this month.



By the grace of God, the children and young people of the home

have been invited to give performances at different schools in the State of Mexico, receiving recognition from the government authorities. We have also had the opportunity to share the gospel



through music and the testimonies of the teenagers.

All the children and young people in the home had a check-up with the Ophthalmologist. God supplied glasses and treatment for the children and young people who needed it.





We took two vehicles for mechanical service. One of the vehicles needed significant repairs involving the coolant system and suspension. Although the repairs were costly, we thank God for supplying the means to accomplish the repairs.
