We are certainly thankful for each and every one of you who have supported us in this ministry the Lord has given us. We came to Ghana about six and a half years ago, and we have seen Him work in our lives in powerful ways. As we continue to go forward, the incredible amount of support we have received and continue to receive from so many, and in so many ways, humbles us brings to mind how truly blessed we are to be serving God here in Kumasi.

I am happy to report that on October 9 we held our first Sunday service at the Bible study in Asokore Mampong. It was a wonderful day filled with blessings from the Lord. We were thrilled to see our benches nearly full of adults and children. Several people who were a part of the Bible study in Bokro under Bro. Andrew Aaron live near our meeting place and have committed to attending the services going forward. One of those people is a young man named Albert. I had the privilege of preaching the gospel to Albert back in 2019 just before we took our first furlough. I was overjoyed to hear that, shortly after we left Ghana, Albert believed the gospel and became born again. He has been a faithful believer with a desire to serve the Lord. He is now translating for me in most of the services. Bro. Yen Adams and his family have also joined with us after attending the Bible study in Bokro for the last few years. He and his wife and 5 children are another tremendous blessing. We are also so happy that our friend Degraft and his children now have a church to attend that is only a few minutes from their home. They no longer have to travel 90 minutes or more each Sunday to attend services. We are now having three services a week. We look forward to seeing how God will bless this new work. He has led us to this point and we fully intend to continue following Him step by step as He leads us on.

We do have a special prayer request for you at this time. Kelly has been struggling with her health for some time. Last month she was able to contact a natural doctor in the States who has helped her to develop a treatment for her autoimmune issues. The problems that she has been experiencing are not going to be resolved quickly, but at this point her body is responding favorably to the treatment. This illness has affected her ability to function normally in day to day activity. We are praying that healing continues and that she will return to full health as soon as possible. Please pray that we will be able to continue to find all the necessary supplements that she needs to heal her body. We need to find them here as shipping them in from abroad could be problematic. We know our God is the Great Physician and we trust Him to bring healing in His time. Please pray for Kelly and the rest of our family as we work through this difficult time.
