Hello, once again. I pray this letter finds you all well. It's true that we are living in very interesting times. There is much uneasiness and uncertainty that surrounds every day life like we have not seen before. I am more thankful than ever that we serve the Almighty God who is over all. We can take courage in knowing that our Lord is still supreme no matter how out of control our world is. We have been called to preach the Gospel to the world, and nothing should ever supersede that mission.

We have spent the first part of this year in preparation for the work of planting a new church in Asokore Mampong. We have invested time in getting our family back into a routine here in Kumasi and adjusting not only to life, but everyday schooling and living in a new environment. God is good, and has helped us as we have tackled new challenges as our family grows. Please pray for the continued adjustment of our family as we face new hills to climb and grow together as a family that will be able to bring honor to God and be a good testimony for Him.

We have started getting out into Asokore Mampong and getting the lay of the land. I am having our tracts printed up and we will very soon begin the first canvassing of the area. Our first goal will be to speak face to face with as many people as possible and get our tracts into their hands. The message in the tracts is valuable in and of itself but the broader hope is that they will keep our contact information and we will be able to make new relationships. There is nothing more productive than face to face meetings where we can open the Scriptures and share the Gospel in a personal way. I have determined the starting point in the middle of the community where we will work first. From there we will begin to spiral out into the surrounding areas. My friend, Degraft, who is a member of Biblical Baptist Church in Atonsu, has decided to join us as much as he can on Saturdays to go out and preach the Gospel and hand out tracts. He lives in the village of Kenyasi, which is just to the north of Asokore Mampong. The church that we are working to start would be much closer to him and he has a great desire to help us get it started. He is fluent in Twi and English and will be a tremendous help to the ministry. Please pray for this new endeavor. I know that God is in this and that He will lead us forward. We desire to simply follow Him and be obedient to the Great Commission.

One of the young ladies that attends Biblical Baptist church was baptized a couple of weeks ago along with a mother and her son from the Bible study in Bokro. We rejoiced that these precious souls were added to the body of Christ. As I stood on the hill watching them be dipped in the river below, my thoughts turned to the future and I began to long for the day that I will be able to baptize the first person into the membership of the church the Lord has called us to plant. Our desire is strong to see it begun. Pray for us as we do the work, that God would give the strength and wisdom we need to see it through. Thank you all for your continued support. We love you and pray God's blessings upon you.
