We will always remain very grateful to you for your sponsorship, support and partnership in our call to reach our people with the GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST. We see the reality of our call in the Lord's call on the Apostle Paul in Acts 26:18. May our good Lord continue to be our strength and shepherd.**

**The Lord has continued to open doors for us to tell people of His love and willingness to save all who will come to Him. First the Radio Ministry. I had some problems with the man who had been helping with my recordings and we had to part ways. A young man called Joseph has stepped in and is doing a good job for me. Our estimate makes us realize we are reaching not less than two million souls with His Word per broadcast both in English and my native language. We have been receiving responses that gladden our hearts very much. Mostly by phone calls. Recently however, a young man walked into my house to have a discussion with me because of a message on forgiveness. We had a very fruitful discussion. A man called John called to let me know he has been bed-ridden for some four years now and unable to go to church. He said he has been listening faithfully for all these years and is very grateful.**

**Our missions at Tsibu and Todome are also doing quite well. These are missions in the Volta region and are headed by former students from our Training Institute. Both of them are trying to put up permanent meeting places. They are of the Ewe tribe. That is Gloria's tribe. When we visit I normally preach in English and the leaders translate. I later ask Gloria if the translations were okay.**

**One of the areas of the ministry I enjoy very much is when I get the privilege to have a one-on-one study time with anyone. The Lord blessed me with one not too long ago. Samuel and I have been meeting regularly until he got a job. He has a great desire to continue with the studies, but he must work to take care of his family. Please pray for us to be able to reschedule properly so he can have his job and we can have our study time too. It seems the two men I met some time ago where I stopped to buy the mushrooms are back in the village. Their jobs have stalled and I plan reconnecting. Hopefully we will continue from where we left off.**

**Even though Brother Abraham is now the Pastor of Asewewa Grace Baptist Church, I try to work close with him because of the six missions in his area. We are trying to finish the training for the**

leaders of two of the missions so we can ordain them as their pastors. Please pray with us in this endeavor.

October is festival month for my tribe and as usual we love to share lots of tracts during this period. We are preparing and we will love for you to join us in prayer.

My family is doing well. Gloria and I have been having our medical checkups which have helped a lot. We are trusting the Lord to keep us healthy for His service. Our young men (Makafui and Senyo) and young ladies (Delali and Selasie) are all doing well.

May our Good Lord continue to bless and keep you all in His wonderful grace.
