ORDINANCE NO. 172

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEVEN POINTS, TEXAS ADOPTING AN ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEVEN POINTS, TEXAS:

SECTION I

That a Special Election was held in the City of Seven Points, Texas on Saturday, August 8, 1987, same being the second Saturday in August, at Seven Points City Hall;

SECTION II

That said Special Election was to vote "For" or "Against" Proposition: Adoption Of An Additional One-Half Of One Percent Sales And Use Tax Within The City;

SECTION III

That the Election results were canvassed on August 11, 1987 and the tabulation of the votes are as follows:

Votes For: 80
Votes Against: 14
Undecided Vote: 1
TOTAL VOTES: 95

SECTION IV

That the Proposition was approved by 65 votes.

SECTION V

That the City Secretary shall forward to the Comptroller by U.S. Registered Mail or Certified Mail, a certified copy of this Ordinance, and shall also forward a copy of the Minutes in which this Ordinance was passed and approved upon.

SECTION VI

That effective date of the tax be on the first day of the calender year succeeding the elapsed quarter, making the effective date of the tax January 1, 1988.

SECTION VII

That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as provided by law.
