ORDINANCE NO 304

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SEVEN POINTS, TEXAS TO AMEND CHAPTER 5, SECTION 1, FIRE PROTECTION; PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEVEN POINTS, TEXAS:

THAT CHAPTER 5, SECTION 1., OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: ADOPTION OF FIRE PREVENTION CODE

There is hereby adopted for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion, that certain code known as the International Fire Code 2000 as recommended by the Southern Building Code Congress International, Inc. A copy of said Code has been and now is filed in the office of the city secretary and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out in length herein,

SECTION 2: ENFORCEMENT

The duly appointed Fire Marshal shall have the responsibility for enforcing the provisions of the International Fire Code 2000 herein adopted.

SECTION 3: AMENDMENTS TO STANDARD FIRE PREVENTION CODE

Section 108 of the International Fire Code 2000 is hereby revised to read as follows:

APPEALS

Whenever it is claimed that the provisions of the International Fire Code 2000 do not apply or the fire official shall reject an alternate material, method of construction, or when it is claimed that the true intent and meaning of this chapter has been misinterpreted, the owner or his duly authorize agent may appeal the decision of the fire official to the city council.
