

ORDINANCE NO. 203

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEVEN POINTS, TEXAS CREATING THE OFFICE OF CITY ATTORNEY; AMENDING AND REPEALING ANY AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEVEN POINTS, TEXAS:

WHEREAS the City of Seven Points recognizes the need for a City Attorney therefore creating such office.

WHEREAS the City of Seven Points creates the office of City Attorney pursuant to the Texas Municipal Law Manual, L.G.C. §203.025. Quote: "Other officers of the City shall be a treasurer, an assessor or collector of taxes, a secretary, a city attorney, a marshall, a city engineer, and such other officers and agents as are authorized by the city council from time to time. These officers may either be appointed or elected as the city council may provide by ordinance. The city council may confer the powers and and duties of one or more of these offices upon other officers of the city."

WHEREAS the City Attorney office is created and said office shall be appointed by the City Council of Seven Points, Texas.

WHEREAS the powers and duties of City Attorney shall be prescribed by the City Council upon the appointment of same.

WHEREAS the City Attorney will be compensated by a retainer or by hourly fee as set forth by the City Council.


WHEREAS this ordinance shall repeal and amend any previous ordinance and shall provide for a severability clause.
