

ORDINANCE NO. 237

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SEVEN POINTS, TEXAS, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 16; DISCHARGING FIREARMS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEVEN POINTS, TEXAS:

THAT CHAPTER 1, SECTION 16 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 16: DISCHARGING OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS

It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation or association to fire or shoot or cause to be fired or shoot any firearm, rifle, shotgun, automatic rifle, revolver, pistol or any other weapon designed for the purpose of firing or discharging a shell or cartridge, whether such shell or cartridge is blank or live ammunition, at any place within the corporate limits of the City of Seven Points, except for the protection of private property, except peace officers while in the performance of their official duties, and except for persons qualifying for a concealed handgun license at an approved shooting range with approval of the Police Chief.
