

**ORDINANCE NO. 246**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SEVEN POINTS, TEXAS; TO AMEND CHAPTER 4, SECTION 5 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, HOURS OF SALE), ADDING ITEM E., PROVIDING FOR RECENT ANNEXATIONS; PROVIDE FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEVEN POINTS, TEXAS:**

**THAT CHAPTER 4, SECTION 5 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 5: ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, HOURS OF SALE**

**E. HOURS OF SALE; (ANNEXED PROPERTY)**

- (1) Property which has been annexed since the effective date of ordinance providing for Alcoholic Beverages, Hours of Sale, will have the same hours of sale set out in the Code of Ordinances Chapter 4 Section 5.

**SEVERABILITY CLAUSE**

Should any section or provision of these amendments to the **CODE OF ORDINANCES** be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the **CODE OF ORDINANCES** as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be unconstitutional.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance will take effect April 23, 1996 from and after its passage.
