

**CITY OF SEVEN POINTS
CITY COUNCIL
MINUTES
October 6, 2025**

The city councils of Seven Points, Texas called an emergency meeting to finalize the FY 26 budget.

1. Call to order and Roll Call: Mayor Keith Betts, Mayor Pro-Tem LaJohnna Wells, Council Members Andy Perdue, LaJohnna Wells, Kevin Reynolds, Mary Wennerstrom, and Valerie Bahm. (Quorum present/not present) A quorum was present.
2. Chief Raymond Wennerstrom led the invocation, and Mayor Betts led the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. A motion was made by Kevin Reynold to approve expenditures paid from October 1, 2025 through October 6, 2025, in lieu of an operating budget. Second by LaJohnna Wells. The vote was five (5) for and none were opposed. Motion carried.
4. Mayor Keith Betts read line 4 to review and consider Ordinance #386 providing for adoption of a budget for the City of Seven Points to adopt FY 2026 Budget. Before a motion was called for Council member LaJohnna stood up to begin reading a motion she had written out. She stated the motion was to approve the detailed budget that Mary Wennerstrom (pointing to Mary) presented tonight making sure to exclude from the budget full-time, part-time and contractual contracts that have not been executed or approved by city council. This would also include from the budget all contractual agreements or amendments or personnel changes lacking detailed minutes of approval made by council. During this time Mayor Betts hit the gavel several times and told LaJohnna he had not called for a motion and he was not recognizing her motion. She stated she had she had sought legal counsel and what she is doing is legal. Mayor Betts continued to say it was not that we did not present Mary's budget, and we were voting on the one presented to the people. Currently Council Member Valeri Bahm second (2nd) the motion. At this time the three (3) council women voted on the motion. The mayor still has called for a motion or a second vote. Council member Charles Longacre attempted to settle the council down stating we must pass a budget, and we needed to get this done. After a few minutes without progress being made, Charles Longacre and Kevin Reynolds left the minutes.

The mayor was forced to call the meeting due to we needed at least four (4) council members at a special called meeting.

The meeting was adjourned by Mayor Keith Betts.
